

Tractor Reference for Ford

The following information is being provided to help you identify some of the more popular Ford tractors.

Model Year	How to Identify
9N, 2N 1939-1947	4:00 x 19 front tires; 10.50" bolt circle front wheel; 3 speed transmission. No script on hood or fenders.
8N 1948-1949	4:00 19 front tires; 6" bolt circle front wheel; 4 speed transmission; front mount dist.; fuel door hinges to front. Rotate housings to adjust steering box, script hood, plain fenders.
8N 1950-1952	16" or 19" front tires; 6" bolt circle front wheel; 4 speed transmission; fuel door hinges to front; side mounted dist.; screw adjustable steering box; factory tachometer 1951-1952. Script fenders and hood.
NAA 1952-1954	Fuel door hinges to left' O.H. valve engine 134 C.I.D.; 4 speed transmission; 2" O.O. nut in center rear axle, live hydraulics.
600 1955-1957	Fuel door hinges to left; O.H. valve engine 134 C.I.; 4 or 5 speed transmission; has ammeter. No fuel gauge; Ford script stamped in hood sides; center of rear axle smooth; approximately 4" between bottom of steering wheel and dash panes.
800 1955-1957	Fuel door hinges to left; O.H. valve engine 172 C.I.D.; 4 or 5 speed transmission; has ammeter. No fuel gauge; Ford script stamped in hood sides; center of rear axle smooth; approximately ½" between bottom of steering wheel and dash panel.
601 1958-1962	Fuel door hinges to left; O.H. valve engine 134 C.I.D.; 4 or 5 speed transmission, has fuel gauge & generator warning lamp; Ford script now in decal; center of rear axle smooth; hood painted solid red. Later style (thin) fenders with script.
